The bride graduated from Rockhurst University in Kansas City, Mo., with a bachelor's degree in communiof Zeta Tau Alpha sorority. She re-


ceived a master's degree in communication disorders from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and is a speech-language pathologist at Let's Talk.
